#### From the President's Desk:

We need to start thinking about officer elections for the two year terms starting 1/1/2017. Since our last elected vice president resigned during the 2015-2016 terms we will be voting for President in addition to the normal Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Following are the nomination/election sections of the club bylaws along with the officer duties section of the bylaws. So read these over and lets have some members volunteer to run for these officer positions later this year in accordance with the bylaws. Remember, this is your club and members are needed to help run the club.



Article V Officers

Section 1. Type of officers: the officers of this club shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The past President will become Chairman of the Board upon election of his successor.

A. Nominees for the offices of President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer must be members of MCA and active members in good standing of NEGA Mustang Club, having been a member for at least two years prior to election and attended no less than 75% of meetings and/or events sponsored by NEGA Mustang Club.

B. The Executive Board will be composed of the duly elected officers and the past President, who will serve as Chairman of the Board.

C. Nominations will be taken at the regularly scheduled November meeting and the election will be held at the regularly scheduled December meeting. The newly elected officers will begin their term with the January meeting.

D. Biographies for those running for office should be limited to 50 words or less and may be mailed at the expense of the candidate or all biographies may be included in the newsletter, at the discretion of the Secretary.

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1, A.: Officers will serve two year terms and the Vice President will automatically become the President at the end of his term as Vice-President, if he has fulfilled his obligations as Vice-President and has regularly attended meetings and events sponsored by the Club.

Article VI

Duties and Responsibilities of Officers

Section 1. President - The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the NEGA Mustang Club and shall have general supervision, direction and control of the business and affairs of the club. He shall preside at all regular and executive board meetings of the NEGA Mustang Club. The President shall sign all contracts and other instruments in writing, provided, however, that that the members of the club or the executive board must first approve all contracts and other instruments. Section 2. Vice-President - The Vice-President shall perform all the duties of the President in his absence, and when so acting shall have all the powers and restrictions of the President as set forth in Section 1. The Vice-President shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be prescribed by the Executive Board, and shall attend all their meetings. The Vice-President will assume the duties of the President should he be unable to complete his term.

Section 3. Secretary - The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the members and Executive Board, record the minutes of all meetings, keep or cause to be kept, a current register of members, give notice of all meetings of members and the Executive Board. He or she shall have control of valuable papers and books of the club. In the absence of the Secretary from any meeting of the members or Executive Board, the presiding officer shall appoint a Secretary pro-tempore. Each year, by June 1, the Secretary shall submit to MCA a list of all members of that year.

Section 4. Treasurer - The Treasurer shall keep a correct accounting of the Club's business transactions. He or she shall deposit all monies and other assets in the bank account established for NEGA Mustang Club. He shall disburse the funds of the club as may be ordered by the Executive Board or meetings of the Club, and shall render to the President and the Executive Board an accounting of the Club's assets and liabilities. The Treasurer without specific approval of the Executive Board or a meeting of the Club shall incur no obligation, debt, or other liabilities. The Treasurer is responsible for maintaining adequate funds for month to month expenses to operate the Club, including a reasonable amount of funds designated for future shows or club events. Funds should be deposited in a special account designated for the Club.
