In 2 years I put 1500 miles on it.

When I saw the '15 S550 I fell in love with it. Trading the '04 broke my heart but knew I could not have both. The more I drive the '15 Competition orange GT w/ performance package it eased the pain. In 2 years I have close to 8000 miles. Not a daily drive but I look for any opportunity to drive it. After personalization (blackout) cat back exhaust, intake & tune I still wanted more. As I type this my ROUSH phase 1 supercharger is in shipment! Suspension upgrades are a work in progress.

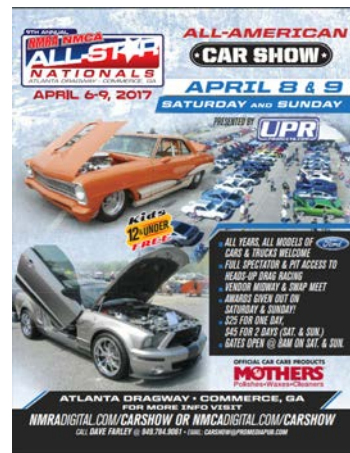
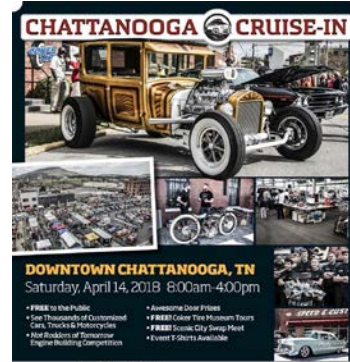

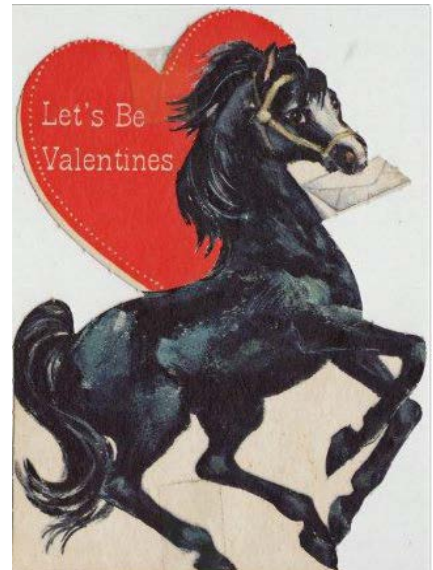
