## **NEGMC Charitable Contribution History**

When Northeast Georgia Mustang Club began sponsoring a Toys for Tots car show, we decided to donate to proceeds to local charities so that we could see the benefit of the donation. We originally gave between \$1200 and \$1500 each year, divided between the Quinn House in Lawrenceville -- a school for developmentally challenged children; Safe Haven Ministries -- a home for displaced boys (now out of existence); Circle of Hope -- a home for abused women and children fleeing abusive spouses; and South Habersham Middle School -- located in Cornelia, (the adjoining town to Demorest, where our club was chartered) which has a substantial population of students who live at or below the poverty level. Local organizations are often operating on a shoe string and find their budgets at the mercy of the economy of the surrounding area. In recent years, many of these organizations have contacted our club to let us know how much they appreciate our support and how our donations have made their work possible. I can personally attest to the need of students at SHMS and the benefit that comes from helping these families. Daphne, our school counselor, is very selective in choosing parents to help. She makes sure that they families are truly in need and will appreciate what is done for them. Each year that our club has donated to the school, students have been helped with essentials such as shoes, jeans, jackets, and school supplies. Daphne always tries to include something extra for the children, but she is a very careful shopper and generally is able to talk local stores into discounts.
