### **Mustang Collectibles**

Last Newsletter I talked about Japanese tin cars. Another type of car collected and more common is what I like to call the large die cast cars. These are either 1:18 or 1:24 scale and are generally pretty well detailed. The level of detail varies as does the cost. Perhaps the most consistent quality and detailed mid priced cars are made by Auto Art. Several other manufacturers such as Ertl, American Muscle, Maisto, Welly, Classic Garage, Hot Wheels & DUB can be found at nearly every car show. Some





newer releases are the "For Sale" series that look like a car under restoration or needing one. If you want the most correct and extremely detailed cars, then look to GMP Diecast. Their cars have correct and high detail and are available in many styles. Most of the large cars can be purchased for \$20.00-\$50.00 at a show or on the internet. Expect to pay \$100.00 or more for the GMP models. Look around. You might just find one that matches your car to put on your mantle.
