MUSTANG COLLECTIBLES

I plan to introduce you to some Mustang collectibles here in the next few months. Mustang collectibles are varied and there is something for nearly everyone. The collectibles in the picture are of Japanese tin Mustangs. They can be animated with battery powered motors. Some go in a straight line, some do burnouts, some flip over and some can run around a table without falling off.

Those are called "Bump n Go". These tin cars can cost as little as 20 bucks in a non operating condition to hundreds of dollars in perfect condition with their original box. The cars shown at the right are 1:18 scale, but they can be in almost any scale. Some can be pretty large. A

good source for these tin cars is e-bay and the vendors at car shows or toy shows. Look for more Mustang Collectibles here next month.
